Transparency Act statement

Background

Glasopor AS produces and sells a lightweight building material, particularly well suited for use in demanding ground conditions. The product is made from 100% recycled glass packaging collected from Norwegian households.

The product is used in infrastructure and construction projects and Glasopor operates primarily in the building and construction industry.

Supervisory

The company is certified in a number of ISO standards and thus has a comprehensive management system in place. Monitoring and securing good working conditions and safeguarding human rights throughout the supply chain will be included in the management systems.

Through this, solid grounding in the management and follow-up in the daily work is ensured.

Consequences and risks

To date, the company has not uncovered any objectionable conditions in the supply chain, but it is emphasized that the work on due diligence assessments is in an early phase.

After performing a risk assessment of the main suppliers, the company considers the risk of human rights violations low. The main reason for this is that most of the companys suppliers are based in Norway with Norwegian employees. However, there are some raw materials that are imported and the company will obtain information about these suppliers work in securing basic human rights and decent working conditions in its own value chain.
